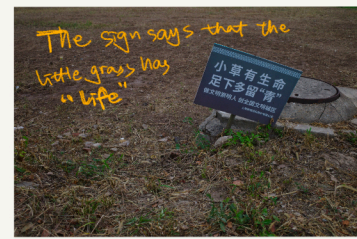

Nature is there.

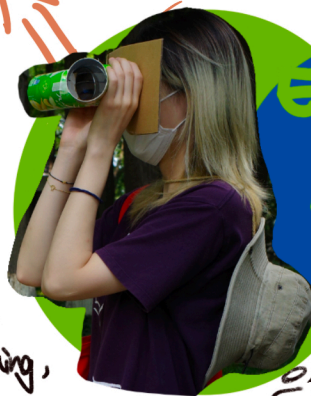
It includes everything.

Thinking of the snail's shell story.



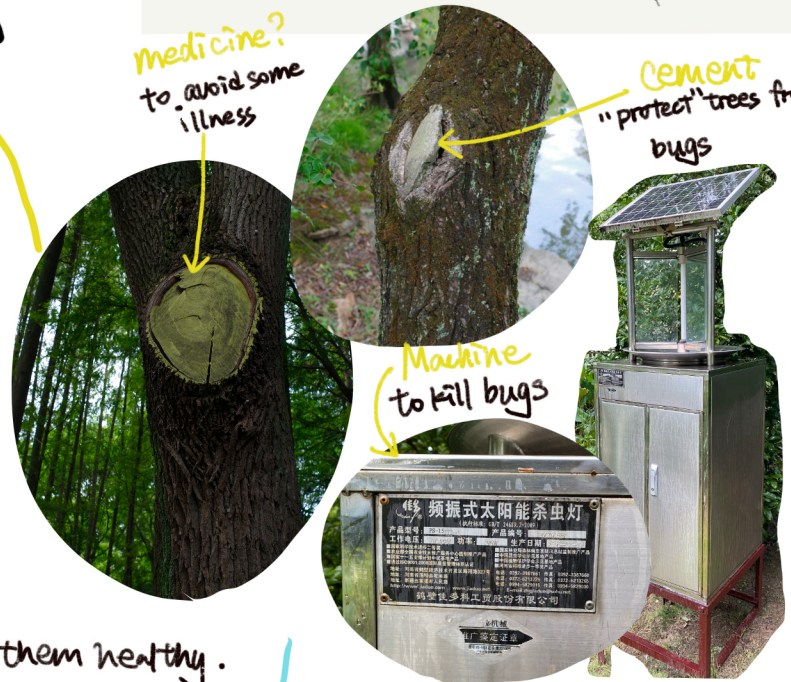
So the trees in the parks are like human's pets??
